PISTOL MARKSMANSHIP COURSE

PREREQUISITE: STUDENTS MUST BE LAW-ABIDING CITIZENS LEGALLY QUALIFIED TO OWN FIREARMS, FOID CARDS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO TAKE THIS CLASS BUT STUDENTS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO HAVE ON IN ORDER TO COMPLY WITH THE STATE OF ILLINOIS "FIREARMS TRANSPORTATION" LAWS.

This 10 hour course serves the needs of both new and experienced shooters alike. If you're thinking about purchasing a handgun for yourself or a family member and don't know what to buy, this class will address your questions. If you're uncomfortable around firearms and want to overcome your concerns, this is an opportunity to experience firearms safety instruction in a positive, non-threatening atmosphere. If you learned to shoot on your own or from a friend and just want to polish your technique, this class is for you. This is an excellent opportunity to experience one-on-one training from competent, experienced instructors at an attractive price.

The course includes classroom lecture and live fire exercises.

Water and some generic soft drinks will be provided. If you have a personal preference or special drink, bring it.

Ammunition will be provided.

NRA PISTOL INSTRUCTOR COURSE

PREREQUISITE: ATTENDANCE AT AN NRA BASIC PISTOL COURSE. ALL CANDIDATES FOR THE POSITION OF CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR MUST BE 21 YEARS OLD OR OLDER AND LEGALLY QUALIFIED TO POSSESS A FIREARM.

This 12 hour course equips the instructor candidate to **TEACH** Basic NRA Courses. If you possess a solid background in firearm safety and shooting skills, are 21 years old, have a FOID card, have a desire to pass on your knowledge to others and are willing to make a commitment to organize and teach Basic NRA Courses, this course is for you.

The course includes classroom lecture, classroom & range exercises and live fire exercises.

The NRA 3 step training process. The elements of Total Participant Involvement.
Student evaluation techniques. The characteristics, sources and proper use of training aids and materials.
Teaching principles and teaching methods. Shooter coaching techniques.
