A Gun Ban by Another Name

OPPOSE

SB-1007 bans magazines that hold more than 10 rounds of ammunition. It doesn't matter what type of gun, if the magazine holds more than 10 rounds of ammunition, it becomes ILLEGAL.

SB-1007 Applies to Lever Action and Pump Action Firearms. this amendment applies to **any** magazine that holds more than 10 rounds of ammunition. It applies to firearms with fixed magazine capacity of more than 10 rounds like the 1860 Henry Rifle. It would also apply to pump shotguns like the Remington 870.



1860 Henry Rifle
Banned Under SB-1007

John Wayne & Roy Rogers Would Be Criminals. Guns like the 1876 Winchester, the 1860 Henry and others of that period, as well as modern lever action rifles would be illegal for sale.

Magazines Treated the Same as Firearms. Under SB-1007 it is illegal to transport a "high capacity" magazine unless it is unloaded and enclosed in a case, not immediately accessible or broken down in a non-functioning state. An empty pistol magazine on the floor of a pick-up truck with no firearm present, would be a criminal offense. Current law only places restrictions on ammunition when a firearm is present. SB-1007 allows for criminal penalties for mere possession of magazines and ammunition when no firearm is present.

SB-1007 Will Cost Illinois Jobs. Illinois is home to several firearms manufacturers. They all build guns that would be effected by SB-1007. If passed, SB-1007 would force them to relocate to another state.
